## Ocean Experience

### Deckhand on Classic Sail Motor Yacht Atlantide (37 m) September 2025- Current

As part of a two-person deck team, I supported a wide range of deck operations, including general maintenance, docking procedures, tender driving, chase-boat upkeep, washdowns, rig maintenance, and polishing. I consistently contributed to delivering a high-quality guest experience and assisted with interior duties when required. Working within a fleet environment allowed me to take on diverse roles and responsibilities, adapting to the needs of each operation. This experience has motivated me to continue expanding my skillset and step into positions with greater responsibility onboard.

### Deckhand on SY Far II Kind (22 m) May 2025 - July 2025

After working on a Motor Yacht for just under a full year I branched back into sail when a wonderful opportunity came up. I have worked as a first mate on Far II Kind. I have primarily assisted in deck maintenance and washdowns etc as well as docking procedures and sailing. In addition to this I was required to work on the interior when guests were onboard as well as cook for them on the occasion that they decided to remain onboard for a meal.

My time on Far II Kind has been an experience where I have had to be quick on my feet, learn how to handle stressful situations efficiently and wear many hats to assist in all areas where I could. Since joining the boat has moved back into a shipyard period.

### Deckhand on MY Flying Manta (43 m) August 2024- May 2025

I started on MY Flying Manta as temporary crew which after 2 months turned into a permanent position. Primarily I have worked as the second deckhand on board MY Flying Manta. I joined a crew of 6 starting my temporary position in shipyard preparing the boat for sale viewings. My role was primarily second deckhand however during the shipyard period I was presented the opportunity to work in a variety of areas including the interior, engine room as well as exterior.

Some of my tasks during shipyard included jobs like installing a new ceiling in the engine room, assisting with insulation installments and piecing back together exhaust covers, making gaskets along with many other hands on jobs to assist in where I was needed and able to help out. The boat had been in shipyard for roughly 8 months when I joined her. After a month in shipyard, post me joining, we set off on our passage from Falmouth, UK, to Monaco. I was expected to perform my daily deckhand duties as well as cover watch under passage as well as at anchor and in port. During my time onboard I was also part of helio operations and crane operations.

I really enjoyed my time on board Flying Manta, switching between our shipyard period to boss trips, winter period and the start of a busy season has encouraged me to learn as much as I could from every opportunity presented to me. I was able to adapt and learn quickly on the job to work seamlessly into a small close knit crew. Since joining the yacht the vessel has sold to a new owner with new crew.

### Deck stew on SY Masa Yume (25 m) Temp June- August 2024

As a temporary position I worked as a sole stew on board SY Masa Yume as well as being a second deckhand. I was responsible for housekeeping, service, detailing and provisioning as well as anchoring, lines and driving the 10m tender on board. This role was mostly involved with organization and preparing the boat for a boss trip for the month. The boat had been in shipyard for 2 years, I was responsible for getting it ready for the season after joining it in Italy and making the trip to Monaco thereafter.
